The Workshop

Will introduce delegates to the concept and practice of lean construction and process waste elimination. Delegates will take part in a simulation exercise to experience first hand some of the key concepts of lean construction and how lean thinking can be practically applied to improve operations.

Following on from this highly interactive morning session, the afternoon will explore successful deployment of lean thinking to construction processes and projects.

Lean construction is not new and although not yet widely accepted, there are many case studies available. The following are examples of outcomes achieved by early adopter companies.

- On time, void maintenance, delivery from 60% to 100%
- Gross profit from 30% to 44%
- Construction build times typically reduced by 25%
- Defects reduced by 90% in timber frame
- Tender applications hit rate improved from one in six to four in six
- Productivity improved by 25% on reactive maintenance
- 55% improvements on planned activities achieved on the design process

CEOs, Operations Directors and Managers, Project Managers, Housing Officers, Clients, Construction Managers, Maintenance Managers and anyone responsible for improving operations in a construction setting.
